Research Time Out (RTO)

Aim:

Research Time Out is a funding instrument that frees up scientifically active personnel for research-related activities. The aim is to advance internationally recognized research in the established biomedical and biopsychosocial research fields of the KL and to promote the development of new research priorities.

Implementation:

- Release of scientific staff for research activities over a longer period (minimum of three months up to maximum of two years with optional extension).
- Higher professional qualification (e.g., PhD, habilitation)



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Financing: Assumption of the personnel costs of scientifically active staff to the extent of 20-50% of the working time with an unchanged employment contract

Requirement: concrete project proposal with an existing ethics vote (if relevant)

Eligible participants: scientifically active personnel of the university hospitals of the KL

Submission: ongoing, online applications in English, 3-4 cut-off dates/year, https://opencampus.kl.ac.at/en/my-research-project-proposals

Selection process: external review
