

## Research bonus

### Aim:

- Motivation of the scientific staff to acquire third-party funding competitively
- Increase in the share of competitively acquired third-party funds in the total research budget
- Autonomy in project management
- Simplify research-relevant follow-up activities
- Facilitate scientific exchange (e.g., through workshops, and smaller events with an expert audience)
- Involve young scientists at an early stage
- Increase visibility of research activities

### Financing:

A bonus of 20% of the KL dedicated funding amount (max. € 30,000) for relevant use in the context of the project/department.

### Requirements:

- Conclusion of a funding agreement (funding body must not be Lower Austria)
- Third-party funds are competitively acquired
- Project registered in [KRIS](#)

Project leaders and partners of the university hospitals and of the KL (if clinicians are involved in the project)
