ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- › Bachelor degree in Health Sciences from Karl Landsteiner University
 - › Alternatively, an equivalent qualification (minimum 180 ECTS)
 - › For applicants whose first language is not German proof of German language proficiency in the form of a certificate from a German-language secondary school, or the Goethe-Certificate C1 issued by the Goethe Institut, or the ÖSD Mittelstufe Deutsch certificate, or a CEFR level C1 qualification

The Human medicine master degree is the second part of our Bologna-compliant medical education programme and connects to our Health Sciences bachelor degree. Besides providing scientific training for further education and subsequent entry into the medical profession, the programme is geared towards developing the skills needed by independent practitioners.

- › practical training at Krems, St.Poelten and Tulln university hospitals
- › all-round individual supervision
- › specialisation during the programme
- › integrated study of biomedical engineering and health economics

The training students receive forms an excellent foundation for careers in the medical profession. Graduates will demonstrate a high level of medical expertise, first-class communication competencies, the ability to work cooperatively and interprofessionally, as well as advanced interdisciplinary communication and problem-solving skills.

CAREER PERSPECTIVES

After completing the Human Medicine programme students are awarded the title of doctor of Medicine (Dr.med.

univ.) and will be qualified to obtain a licence to practice medicine. Specialisation during the degree programme opens the door to attractive careers in some of the most important fields of modern medicine, including biomedical engineering, health care management, and clinical research.

STRUCTURE

The emphasis of the training lies in the area of clinical practice, whereby the lessons are held in modules. A large part of the training takes place according to a rotation principle through the departments of our clinics in very small groups directly at the bedside. The entire study is accompanied by units in „Professional Development“. The aim is to train professional behaviour in the medical or health science profession and thus to





accompany personal development and the professional socialisation process. The learning progress is continuously documented by means of an e-portfolio and enables students to constantly monitor their development.
