

Organisational structures of departments of Karl Landsteiner Privatuniversität für Gesundheitswissenschaften GmbH (KL)

General

1. The NÖ Landesgesundheitsagentur, as the legal entity of the NÖ Landeskliniken, is obliged to ensure public health care. This has to be taken into consideration regarding teaching and research of the KL.
2. The member of the board of NÖ Landesgesundheitsagentur, responsible for human resources, is responsible for providing sufficient and appropriately qualified personnel resources.
3. Representation within the constitution of KL.
4. KL fulfils its research and teaching tasks in the clinical part in cooperation with the following public hospitals:
 - a. Landeskrankenhaus St. Pölten – KL university hospital
 - b. Landeskrankenhaus Krems – KL university hospital
 - c. Landeskrankenhaus Tulln – KL university hospital
5. Divisions and institutes of these university hospitals will bear the designation "department".

Organisational outline

1. The organisational outline of the clinical part of the KL and the above-mentioned university hospitals is coordinated and based on an agreement between NÖ Landesgesundheitsagentur and KL.
