

## 1. Privacy Policy for Mobility Survey

This privacy policy provides information about how your personal data is processed in connection with the mobility survey at Karl Landsteiner University.

### **Processing Purposes**

The data is collected to analyze the mobility patterns of staff, faculty, and students in order to calculate the university's greenhouse gas footprint and to plan and improve the university's mobility services and infrastructure.

### **Legal Basis**

Data processing is carried out on the basis of legitimate interest pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The University's legitimate interest lies in:

- determining mobility-related CO<sub>2</sub> emissions
- developing sustainable mobility measures
- improving infrastructure and services

### **Processed Data**

The following data, in particular, will be processed as part of the survey:

- Information on mobility patterns (e.g., mode of transportation, trip distances)
- Information on employment/student status (e.g., role, days present)
- Location-related information (e.g., primary location, residential ZIP code if applicable)
- Sociodemographic information (e.g., age group, gender)
- Timestamp of participation

The participation in the survey is voluntary.

### **Data Disclosure**

An external service provider is engaged to conduct and analyze the mobility survey:

- HERRY Consult

This provider processes the data on behalf of Karl Landsteiner Private University pursuant to a data processing agreement in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR.

No further disclosure to third parties takes place.

### **Processing and Analysis**

The collected data is analyzed exclusively in aggregated form.

This means that results are summarized in such a way that no conclusions can be drawn about individual persons.

### **Retention Period**

Personal data will be stored only for as long as is necessary to conduct and analyze the mobility survey.

Once the analysis is complete, the data will be deleted or anonymized, provided there are no legal retention requirements to the contrary.

### **Providing Data**

Providing your data is voluntary.

There are no negative consequences if you do not participate in the survey.

## 2. What are your data protection rights

The EU-GDPR defines the following rights and imposes the obligation on data controllers to comply with them.

- right of access
- right to rectification
- right to erasure
- right to restriction of processing
- right to data portability
- right to object to processing
